



TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THAYER DIGITAL (ONLINE AND VIRTUAL) COURSES

The course you have registered for (the “Course”) may contain online, asynchronous programs and/or live, virtual programs. The Course is owned by Thayer Leader Development Group, Incorporated (“Thayer”), 674 Thayer Road, West Point, New York 10996. CorpU, a Udemy company (“CorpU”), provides the system platform for the online programs contained in the Course. The virtual programs contained in the Course may be hosted by providers such as Microsoft Teams, Zoom, GoToWebinar, WebEx or another platform provider.

Your registration and participation in the Course are governed by the provisions contained in these Terms and Conditions (the “Terms and Conditions”).
